





### Diversity

We value diversity, and our staff come from a wide variety of cultures. We employ pioneering research, extensive performance data and stakeholder feedback to enable us to understand and address inequalities.

### Online learning capability

To support our on-campus learning, we have committed to an online mobile-first teaching and learning setup that puts community and conversation at its core. Students now use Aula\*, our online learning platform, to help support on-campus studies. It fosters learning communities and a sense of belonging, while encouraging you to work in a connected and collaborative manner.



### Health and wellbeing

### Academic support

The Lanchester Library is open 24/7, 364 days a year, and is home to 1,400 study spaces, including group and silent areas. We currently offer more than 550 computers and an additional 120 free-to-loan laptops. Our Academic Liaison Librarians can offer specialist subject support and help you access more than 142,000 ejournal titles, 331,000 ebooks and 313,000 print books (figures may change).

Quiet study is available in the Postgraduate Reading Room – a dedicated study space for postgraduates. Incorporating our Disruptive Media Learning Lab (DMLL), we aim to inspire and challenge you to think and act differently when studying, offering experimental learning areas such as The Grass and The Hill.



### Academic writing support

The Centre for Academic Writing (CAW) is a friendly team of academic writing tutors who can provide you with a range of support services, including:

- individualised academic writing tutorials
- workshops on common academic writing development topics, and
- "Single Question Drop-in" sessions.

CAW also provides academic writing resources so you can work through key skills at your own pace.

# Postgraduate Research Degrees

Undertake a postgraduate research degree with Coventry University and become part of a forward-thinking and thriving community. Carry out important research in our specialist areas, which include Arts and Communities, Future Mobility and Data, Health and Wellbeing, Peace and Security, Clean Growth and Sustainability, and Business.



We design our research degrees to fit around you. We offer a diverse range of flexible programmes that cater for people at different stages of their careers, including full-time and part-time options. From Peace and Conflict master's programmes to PhDs in Global Education, we strive to support the next generation of researchers.

Your passions and priorities are what matters most. That's why we have invested in areas that we believe pose the most significant challenges to humanity. A team of leading researchers and a dedicated network of like-minded colleagues will support you and your work.

As well as the opportunity to devise your own research projects, we offer a range of pre-designed doctoral studentships by leading experts from across our research centres. These opportunities are often fully funded, allowing you to undertake a project that responds to a specific contemporary issue.

We have modern facilities where you can undertake your work. Our advanced health and life sciences buildings house industry-standard research laboratories. Our Centre for Future Transport and Cities boasts a wide range of technology, equipment and centres, including the National Transport Design Centre (NTDC), which houses a mixed reality buck and interactive power wall. We also have a range of alternative research sites, including new digital and immersive environments. Our research facility based locally to our Coventry campus comprises laboratories, greenhouses, poly tunnels and farmland for fieldwork projects.

### Celebrating excellence

Each year, we hold several celebratory events that recognise and celebrate postgraduate excellence. In 2021, PhD candidate Saif Alatrash was Coventry University's Postgraduate Researcher of the year for his work on gamified storytelling experiences. Rovier Verdi won the annual 'Three Minute Thesis' competition with his presentation on sustainable food production.

### Global collaborations



Odella Van Stryp was the first candidate to complete Coventry University's 'cotutelle programme' with Stellenbosch University South Africa in 2021. Odella received world-class supervisory support from both institutions for her research on promoting and enhancing the development of young children through scientifically based programmes focusing on children's gross motor skills.

### Looking after our Postgrad community

Our Doctoral College and Centre for Research Capability and Development (RECAP) was shortlisted for 'Best Wellbeing Initiative' Postgrad Award 2021. Hosted annually by FindAPhD and FindAMasters, the awards recognise leading initiatives developed by universities across the UK. Coventry University's wellbeing initiative was established in 2019 and comprises several activities designed to support the Postgraduate Research community.

### Next-generation research leaders



# A culture to be proud of

With its rich history and diverse population, Coventry is a great place to study and live. Our main campus is in the heart of the city centre, and our students play an integral part in the city's lifeblood.



Coventry is a great place for students to live, study and play. If you like live theatre, you are well-catered for, with currently five different theatres nearby, including the Belgrade Theatre. Take a dive and visit our indoor water park, 'escape rooms', ice rink and virtual reality experiences for something a little different.

Movie-goers currently have three cinemas to choose from, and music fans have plenty to enjoy too, with live venues such as the Ricoh Arena, The Golden Cross, The Kasbah, Empire and more.

For food-lovers, there's something for every taste and budget with Coventry's vast selection of high-street favourites, markets, and independent retailers.

If you're into your sports, The Ricoh Arena is home to Premiership rugby union club Wasps, while Coventry RFC, our Championship team, plays at Butts Park Arena. The city is also home to Coventry City Football Club, a top-tier ice hockey team, Coventry Blaze, and a semi-pro rugby league club, the Bears.

For art and history fans, the Herbert Art Gallery & Museum could be worth a visit, especially for its curated arts events. The nearby Fargo Village – the city's creative quarter – looks to run a calendar of events throughout the year.

Back on campus, you'll find social spaces in and around our buildings, especially in our award-winning building, TheHub. ## Students' Union





## Central location

# Study that suits you

Whether you need the flexibility and support to study at a time and place that suits you, or you wish to utilise our fantastic range of facilities, we can offer you a wide range of postgraduate courses, both online and on-campus.

Currently, with more than 140 taught courses across Coventry University, Coventry University London, and Coventry University Online, as well as two types of postgraduate research degrees (master's by research and PhD), we hope you'll find something you like. By evolving our courses to respond to the needs of society, government and business, we look to ensure that your qualification will help you to steer your career in the right direction.

### Certificate (PGCert) and Diploma (PGDip)

- A standalone award.
- Structured in a similar way to a master's course.
- Typically, six to nine months in length.
- Usually assessed by exams and coursework.
- No dissertation required.

### Master's degree

- Usually, intensive taught courses with a dissertation or project.
- Full-time study typically run over one full year.
- Part-time study is typically two years.
- Option to exit the master's early with a postgraduate certificate or diploma – check the course specification or contact the relevant faculty registry for further details.
- Choose from: Master of Arts (MA), Master of Business Administration (MBA), Master of Laws (LLM) and Master of Science (MSc).

### Master's by Research

- Choose from: Master of Arts Research (MAR) and Master of Science Research (MScR).
- Pursue an independent research project with expert supervision and support.
- Typically, one year full-time or two to three years part-time.
- Opportunity to link your research project directly to career interests.

### Master's 100% online






# Investing in your future

As a fundamental element of our corporate strategy, Coventry University continues to invest heavily in its future. We believe that if you commit to making us your chosen place of learning, then we need to give you the very best facilities we can.



Coventry University Group\* is committed to invest over £400m over the next 10 years or so. These include some very significant projects; completed, in progress and due to start in the coming year. This work will enable the development of new, modern spaces, and we are investing significant funds in the coming years to improve the working environment for all our students further.

To improve the campus experience at Coventry, we have opened new cafés, while existing catering provisions have been refreshed and improved. We completed the wider Lanchester Library refurbishment project in summer 2019.

Work is now well underway on a major redevelopment to transform Faculty of Arts and Humanities facilities. Starley Gardens has also opened, creating a calming and relaxing location with views towards Coventry Cathedral.

In the coming years, we aim to continue to invest in the working environment for students and colleagues. Physical environments remain a priority, creating spaces that facilitate an enhanced student experience, support innovative and collaborative study and enable new learning methods.

With every investment in our campus, we aim to enhance our sustainability to help reduce the environmental impact of our infrastructure. The leading environmental charity Keep Britain Tidy has recognised us for the green space established at our city-centre campus in Coventry. Our Edible Garden transformed a previously underused part of our grounds into an educational space for our students and local school groups, as well as being open to the public to harvest the seasonal produce.

## 5G capabilities



In 2020, we deployed the UK's first Standalone 5G network in the Alison Gingell building on our Coventry campus. This delivers benefits that provide the backbone for several large-scale possibilities – such as using the 5G network to roll out next generation virtual reality learning technologies to support education for student nurses and health professionals.

## Health and Life Sciences Building



The Alison Gingell Building, which officially opened in Coventry 2018, has all Faculty of Health and Life Sciences (HLS) practical simulation facilities under one roof for the first time. This provides real-world, hands-on experiences, transforming your training and preparing you for future careers.

## Engineering and Computing Building



The new Beatrice Shilling Building was opened in 2020. This facility includes a gaming and virtual reality studio, a specialist area for 3D printing and rapid prototyping, a laser facility, and physics and electronics laboratories. It links to the existing Engineering and Computing Building with an elevated glass walkway.

## Coventry University London's Cutlers Exchange



Opened in 2019, Cutlers Exchange provides an extra 20,000 square feet of space in addition to University House. Located in Devonshire Square, it comprises teaching spaces, the Postgraduate Centre, the Financial Suite, seven new collaborative working spaces and a new events space.

# Law

## Why study Law?

# How to apply

## UK students

If you are a UK student, you should use our online application portal to apply to study on a postgraduate course (full-time or part-time).

To process your application, we need you to email or upload some key information to the application portal.

- Email one recently dated academic or work reference on official headed paper or emailed from a professional address directly to [ukadmissions@coventry.ac.uk](mailto:ukadmissions@coventry.ac.uk).
- Copies of available academic transcripts.
- Copies of available degree/diploma certificates.
- A portfolio of artwork for art-based courses.
- An English qualification equivalent to GCSE English at grade C (new grade 4) or above.
- Your personal statement.
- A sponsor letter on official headed paper or completed fee authorisation form if you are being sponsored by an employer. (You can download a fee authorisation form from [www.coventry.ac.uk/pgfees](http://www.coventry.ac.uk/pgfees), where you'll also find details of where and when to send the completed form).

We will assess your application on receipt.

## International students

International students should apply online through our application portal.

We also have local representatives in various countries around the world (including China, Nigeria, India, Pakistan, Indonesia, Malaysia, and Hong Kong) who can support you with your application. You can find contact details for the various regions on our website, [www.coventry.ac.uk/international](http://www.coventry.ac.uk/international).

The International Admissions team will need the following information to decide on your application:

- Copies of all relevant academic transcripts.
- Copies of degree/diploma certificates or a work reference if you are employed.
- One academic and/or one work reference on official headed paper (some courses require two reference letters).
- An acceptable English language test score (IELTS or equivalent).
- Your personal statement.
- A copy of your current passport.
- A portfolio, if required, for the course that you are applying to study.

We aim to provide an initial decision on your application within a week.

If you require a Tier 4 visa to study in the UK, you will need to pay a deposit of £4,000 and meet all your offer conditions so that we can issue you with a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) letter. You will then need to pay a second instalment of £4,000 before enrolment.

# Fees and living costs

As a postgraduate student, your two main costs during your studies are likely to be academic fees and living expenses.

## Tuition fees

We calculate course fees based on what it costs to teach each course and they will vary depending on your chosen course of study and your fee status as a UK or international student. Please note that, at the time of going to print, the university has not set its fees for entrants in 2022. We set fees for individual courses, and fees from previous years are no indication of fees for future years.

## Living expenses

If you are choosing where to live in the UK, you may well find your money goes further here in Coventry. While your cost of living depends on your lifestyle and spending habits, Numbeo.com, a worldwide database, reassuringly listed the cost-of-living index in Coventry as 20% lower than in London in August 2021.<sup>1</sup>

## Living costs in Coventry

Here is an approximate guide to the minimum amount you could expect to pay for some usual living expenses in Coventry per month. These costs are for one person only, so please keep this in mind if you are working out a budget that includes children and dependants.

The list does not include food, social, course materials (such as books) and clothing, and you will need to consider paying for travel to and from the university. Remember that Coventry is a more affordable city than London and offers many places to socialise and buy affordable clothing.

## International students

If you are an international student, you must have paid a minimum of £8,000 to complete enrolment. This is typically in two instalments of £4,000. The first instalment must be received to release a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) letter. The second instalment must be paid before enrolment. The remaining balance is payable in full by the end of enrolment or can be split into two equal payments spread over three months.

## UK sports scholarships

Our sports scholarships scheme currently awards scholarships competitively to approximately 30 students each year who have the sporting ability to represent us at a high level. Applications are open to all students participating in a sport recognised by Sport England.

Sports scholarships are for one year and are worth either £3,000 (consisting of up to £1,500 cash and up to £1,500 worth of support) or £1,500 (consisting of £750 cash and £750 worth of support).

This is a one-off payment for the first year of study only. Please note that for part-time students, the scholarship will be paid on a pro-rata basis. You must be a self-funded student, e.g., not sponsored.

We hope that the following information will help you understand how we assess applications for postgraduate qualifications at the university. Please always refer to the specific course pages on our website for the latest and most accurate information regarding detailed entry requirements and tuition fees.

Applications for all postgraduate degree programmes must be made via the university's online application form, which you can find on our main website. Please visit <https://webapp.coventry.ac.uk/cuapply>.

Every course page on our website shows the typical entry requirement grades that you will need to meet to be accepted for that course.

The university considers a wide range of UK and international qualifications for entry to postgraduate courses, and experience admissions practitioners assess qualifications.

As a general guide, the minimum entry requirement for a taught master's course is the equivalent of a 2:2 undergraduate honours degree or above.



## Applicants

If you do not meet minimum entry requirements, we may still admit you if you can demonstrate considerable relevant work experience at an appropriate level. We will send such applications to the course tutor for consideration on an individual basis.

Some of our courses (and especially those that are creative or professional in nature) may also require you to attend an interview before we can confirm your place on the course.
